Make a Timeline of the story. Include at least 7 events. Describe each event in 2 or more sentences and illustrate it.

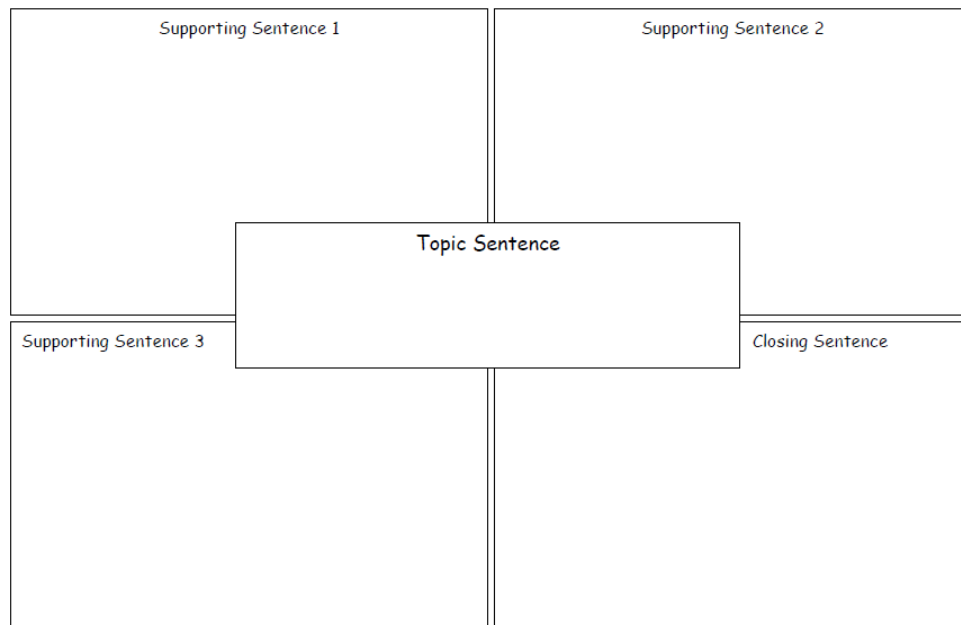
CHOICE #2

Think about it: Consider a problem in the story, and imagine Jesus were a character in the story. How would He have responded to the problem? Why? Write two paragraphs and explain your answer using details. You may use a four square organizer to help you.

CHOICE #3

Draw a picture of your favorite character and the setting. Write a 4-5 sentence paragraph describing each one. Illustrate. You may use a four square organizer to help you organize your ideas.

A 4-square organizer is a way to plan your writing. It looks like this:



In each box you write a few words as note about what you want to say, and then those notes become your sentences. You are not required to use this tool, but it is a good way to help you plan a paragraph.
