Summer reading: (Please have this book read before the first day of school)

1. Mary Poppins, by P.L. Travers ISBN 978-0-544-43956-6

Summer reading project: **(choose 1, Due 1st Friday of school)**

- Create a poster about the book, what was the book mostly about? Make sure you display the main characters, the setting, and the main plot well on your poster
- Create a movie poster. Why should I go see this movie? Make the movie poster interesting and engaging. Make sure you display the main characters, the setting, and the main plot well on your poster
- Write a dialogue between Mary Poppins and Jesus. What could they have talked about? What could they have said to one another? How is Mary Poppins like Jesus, and how are they different? Highlight their similarities and differences. (2 pages typed or written)
- Write a short paragraph summary of each chapter in the book. There are twelve chapters, so there will be twelve paragraphs. Make sure your summaries are clear and stay on the topic of the book. Your summaries should answer three questions: What happened at the beginning of this chapter? What happened in the middle of this chapter? What happened at the end of this chapter? (about 2 pages typed or written)
