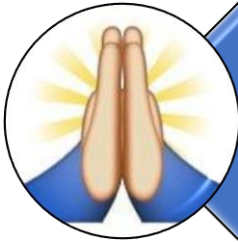


Incoming 7th Graders: Summer Reading

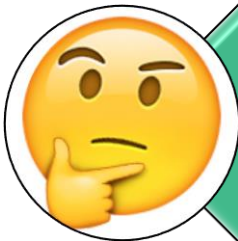
